

# Environmental Expert Shares Solutions for Creating a Sustainable World

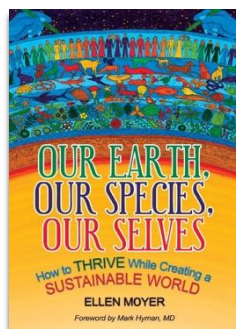
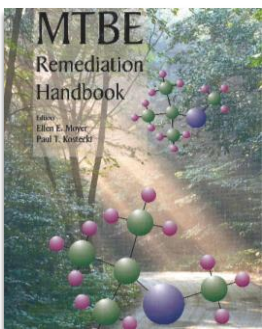
Ellen Moyer, Ph.D., P.E.
